Annual Report 2021-22

The session 2021-22 started with offline mode of teaching after the lockdown during COVID-19 Pandemic. The legacy of success continued in the session 2021-22. It is a testimonial to our commitment to excellence that our students continued to win awards in academics during the session. Our students got merits and distinctions in the university examination. In M.SC. (Mathematics) IV semester, Ramneet Kaur, in M.A. Economics, Sem IV Aanchal Srivastav, in M.Com (Semester IV), four students in B.C.A (Sem VI), fifteen students in BDM (Sem VIII), and eight students got distinction in Guru Nanak Dev University Examination.

Nine National Webinars and Workshops were conducted in the college during the session by various departments on different topics like Environment Issues and Strategies, Gender Equality and Sustainable Development Goals, Website Development Techniques, and Stress Management.
