



In India, especially in Punjab, a majority of the disabled resides in rural areas where accessibility, availability and utilization of services and its cost effectiveness are the major issues to be considered. With this background, this paper focused dimensions of disability in India and particularly in Punjab and also studies various policies and programs relating to disabled population in India and thereby need to strengthen health care and service delivery to disabled population in the country through Universal Health Coverage.
