- Provisional admission granted solely to students listed in the reappear roster of PSEB or equivalent boards.
- Students whose Matric results have been declared late by the Board can enroll in +1 within 15 days of the result announcement without incurring any late fees. Attendance for these students will be recorded from the date of admission.
- Students from Government/affiliated/aided/ associated Institutes, provided their Board is recognized at par with Punjab School Education Board, and who find themselves in the Reappear/ Compartment list of their matriculation exam, are eligible for regular admission in +1 at Hindu Collegiate Senior Secondary School. This is contingent upon successfully passing the matriculation exam in the subsequent two attempts.
- Within a month of admission, the Head of the institute empowered to approve subject/faculty changes.
- Regular students who have failed twice in +2 are eligible to re-enroll in +2 as regular students only.
- Regular students who have been listed in the Compartment/reappear list of the Board for +2 but opt not to retake the exam can choose to re-enroll in +2 by submitting an affidavit confirming the cancellation of their previous result from the relevant Board branch within 30 days of the result declaration.
- Regular students from Government/affiliated/ aided/associated institutes who have passed their +1 examination within the last 3 years, counted from the current session, are eligible to enroll in +2.
- Flexibility offered to students to switch subjects within the same group post +1 examination.
- Migration applicants mandated to furnish a school leaving certificate from the relevant Board, duly signed and attested by a competent authority or the District Education Officer during the academic session or post examination.
- Candidates listed on CBSE and MHRD need not submit equivalence certificates; however, verification of results from Boards other than PSEB mandated by our Institute. Relevant documents such as Migration certificate, DMC, pass certificate, and Transfer certificate, duly countersigned by the DEO, requisite for admission.
- Students who have completed their schooling in another country and seek to pursue education under the PSEB or wish to enrol in different courses after completing +2 must first submit an equivalence certificate issued by the AIU. Additionally, admission can only proceed after the issuance of the equivalence certificate by
- Facilitation for migration is available during either the +1 or +2 academic sessions, subject to recommendations from both institute heads. Eligibility for admission in any school at the initial stage, subject to the registration number appearing on the School Leaving Certificate, until scheduled admission dates.



House Examinations at Hindu College: A Testament to Academic Integrity

- 1. **Participation Mandatory:** Every student is required to partake in House Examinations, affirming their commitment to academic progress and assessment.
- 2. **Attendance Requirement:** Absence from House Examinations, irrespective of leave status, is considered a failure, underscoring the significance of consistent engagement and dedication to learning.
- 3. **Leave Protocol:** Permission for leave from House Examinations is granted solely under exceptional circumstances, primarily on medical grounds, and is subject to approval by the Principal.
- 4. **Medical Certification:** Request for leave on medical grounds necessitate submission of a certificate issued by the College Medical Officer, ensuring authenticity and validating the need for absence.
- 5. **Special Testing:** Students granted leave on medical grounds are obliged to undergo a special test to evaluate their comprehension of covered material, safeguarding academic progress while ensuring fairness in evaluation.
- 6. **Academic Integrity:** Upholding the sanctity of examinations, any student found employing unfair means during House Examinations faces severe repercussions. Reported cases result in the non-assessment of the answer book and nullification of marks for the affected paper, reinforcing the college's stance on academic honesty and fairness.

Excellence Recognized: Academic Prizes at Hindu College

- 1. **Prize Criteria:** Prizes are conferred for outstanding performance in all subjects.
- 2. **Eligibility Requirement:** Prize recipients must have successfully passed all compulsory and elective subjects to qualify, with no exemptions permitted under any circumstances.
- 3. **First Prize Eligibility:** To merit the First Prize in a specific subject, students must attain a minimum aggregate score of 60% in house tests. However, for M.Sc./M.A./M.Com. students, a score of 55% or higher is required.

Note: For M.A., M.Com., and M.Sc. students, each paper is treated as a separate subject.



- 4. **Second Prize Clause:** In instances where no student meets the criteria for the First Prize, only a Second Prize will be awarded for that subject.
- 5. **Second Prize Eligibility:** Students vying for the Second Prize must achieve a minimum aggregate score of 55% in the relevant subject's house tests.
- 6. **Principal's Discretion:** The Principal reserves the right to exercise discretion in awarding prizes to deserving candidates based on merit.

Eligibility Conditions for University Examinations

- 1. **Affiliation Certification:** Students seeking to appear for the University examination in a particular class must furnish certificates, signed by the Principal of their affiliated college, attesting to the following:
 - i) Enrollment on the rolls of an affiliated college for the academic year preceding the examination.
 - ii) Successful completion, one academic year prior, of the lower (qualifying) examination of Guru Nanak Dev University or any equivalent examination recognized by GNDU, meeting the requisite percentage of marks and/or subject combination as stipulated by relevant ordinances.

iii) Attendance Requirements:

- a) Attendance of not less than 75% of the total lectures delivered in each subject offered, up to the final day of classes before preparatory holidays.
- b) Attendance of not less than 75% of the periods allocated for practical work in each Science subject. For Geography, a minimum of 40 periods must be arranged by the college for practical work (e.g., map work).
- c) Attendance of not less than 75% of tutorials for B.Com. students.

iv) Performance Standards:

- a) Attainment of at least 25% aggregate marks in all subjects or 20% marks in each individual subject in House Examinations.
- b) Attainment of at least 30% aggregate marks in a special test, available to defaulting or failing students upon request, with payment of a special exam fee of Rs. 1000.00 per semester.

General Rules

- Compliance with College Regulations: Every student enrolled in the College is obligated to adhere to
 the rules established by the institution, subject to periodic updates, and must strictly adhere to all
 directives issued. It is strongly recommended that students regularly check the College Notice Board for
 important updates and announcements.
- 2. **Disciplinary Measures:** Should a student's conduct be deemed unsatisfactory or in violation of College regulations during their tenure, the Principal reserves the authority to strike their name off the College rolls. The Principal retains the discretion to take such action without providing justification.
- 3. **Identity Card Requirement:** All students are required to carry their Identity Cards while on College premises. Failure to do so may result in heavy fines being imposed on defaulters.

Subject Change Policy

Students have the option to modify their combination of subjects with the approval of the Principal. This can be done within the first 15 days of the commencement of classes by submitting a request and paying a nominal administrative fee of ₹200 for subject change and ₹500 for faculty change. Please note that no changes will be entertained after this initial period.

Admission Procedures & Requirements

1. Document Submission:

Applicants are required to submit a comprehensive set of documents upon presenting themselves at the College. This includes University/Board Certificates, Character Certificate, Aadhaar Card, Voter ID, and SC/ST certificates if applicable. Additionally, students seeking an Eligibility Certificate from GNDU must adhere to the prescribed process and deadline.

To obtain an Eligibility Certificate from GNDU, students who completed their qualifying examination from institutions other than PSEB, Punjab University, Punjabi University, and GNDU must follow a specific procedure. This involves submitting a prescribed application form along with a fee of Rs. 350/- and the following documents:

- i. Original Certificate and DMC of the lower class passed.
- ii. Original Migration Certificate from the Board/University where the candidate completed their lower examination.
- iii. The deadline for obtaining the Eligibility Certificate aligns with the guidelines specified by GNDU.

Additionally, SC/ST candidates must submit a certificate from the competent authority, and students demonstrating proficiency in sports/extra-curricular activities must provide relevant certificates.

Note: While seeking admission, a student must submit four latest passport size photos along with the admission form, failing which his/her admission would be considered invalid.

2. **Provisional Admission:** Candidates whose applications are provisionally accepted must fulfill all requirements, including payment of dues and submission of outstanding information, to be considered for regular admission.

- 3. **Validity of Admission:** Admission is deemed valid only upon fee payment and receipt of the Roll Number Slip, signed by the Principal.

- 5. **Non-Refundable Fees:** Fees and dues paid to the College are non-refundable under any circumstances
- 6. **Discretionary Admission:** The Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse admission without providing justification.
- 7. **Exam Regulations:** Regular students are not permitted to sit for University Examinations as private candidates.
- 8. **Non-Formal Scheme:** Students passing lower/qualifying exams through non-formal schemes are ineligible for regular admission to higher classes.
- 9. **Educational Qualifications:** Admission to the first semester of any undergraduate class requires successful completion of 12 years of schooling from a recognized Board.
- 10. **Language Options:** Certain categories of students may opt for Basic Punjabi/PHC in place of General Punjabi at the graduate level, subject to specified conditions.
- a) Non-Resident Indians or Foreign Nationals.
- b) Those who have passed Matric and/or Senior (+2) Examination with Punjab History and Culture in place of General Punjabi.
- c) Residents of other states of the Union of India whose mother-tongue is not Punjabi and who have not studied Punjabi at any level.
- d) Those who are not domiciles of the State of Punjab. (Domicile Certificate in such cases is to be submitted to the College office along with application for admission.)

A student from any of the aforesaid categories shall have to furnish to the College an affidavit, duly attested by the local Executive Magistrate, on a stamped paper deposing his/her entitlement to take up Basic Punjabi /PHC in lieu of General Punjabi at the time of admission.

Note: The Principal reserves the right to levy a uniform cess for meeting expenditure on unforeseen and emergent development projects of the College.

Eligibility Conditions For Under Graduate Classes

B.A./ B.Sc. (Medical, Non-Medical, Economics, I.T., Computer Science) / DCA /CMLT/Diploma in Cosmetology/B.Com./BBA/BCA/BDM

Only those students shall be eligible for admission to Semester -I Class who have passed:

i) Senior Secondary Certificate Part II Examination of the Punjab School Education Board with minimum of 40% marks except for B.A. & BDM as the eligibility percentage for BDM is 45. OR

ii)Any other examination recognised as equivalent to the aforesaid examination of GNDU, if he/she fulfils other conditions such as combination of subjects and/ or minimum percentage of marks required for that examination.

Note: A candidate for BA/B.Sc. Sem. I Examination shall not opt for Physics, Chemistry, Maths, Botany, Zoology unless he/she has qualified in the same subject in the qualifying examination. A candidate for B.A./B.Sc. Sem -I examination opting for Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology without having qualified it at the qualifying examination may be allowed to qualify it in that/those subject

(s) of the lower examination at the Supplementary Examination held in Sept. of the year of admission to the class. If he/she fails to qualify in that/ those subject (s), his/her admission to B.A/B.Sc. Sem. I class shall stand automatically cancelled and he/she shall have no claim, whatsoever. A candidate shall opt for the same elective subjects in Sem. I to VI of B.A./B.Sc.

The students who pass Senior Secondary Part-II Examination with compartment(s) in a subject(s) will be admitted in the degree classes only after the rules and regulations are laid down by Guru Nanak Dev University for the current session.

The Admission Process at Hindu College

Eligibility Conditions for admission to the Post Graduate Classes

Outlined below are the eligibility criteria for admission to the postgraduate programs offered at Hindu College Amritsar, in affiliation with Guru Nanak Dev University, covering MSc Mathematics, MSc Computer Science, MA Economics, and MCom Accounting and Finance.

1. Students joining M.Sc. (Computer Science) must be graduates with Computer Science/IT/Computer Applications/Computer Maintenance as one of the elective subjects with 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

BCA/B.Sc. (IT) or equivalent thereto with at least 50% marks in aggregate. OR

Graduate with Mathematics as an elective subject or a Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Applications/PG Diploma in Information Tech./PG Diploma in E-Commerce and Internet Application or equivalent with 50% marks in aggregate.

- 2. Students joining M.Sc. (Maths) must have obtained 50% marks in aggregate of BA/B.Sc. or have passed Maths at BA/B.Sc. level with 45% marks, or M.A. in any subject or BA/B.Sc. with Honours in Maths.
- 3. Students joining M.A. (Economics) must have obtained 45% marks in Economics at graduation level or must have obtained 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level with Economics as one of the subjects.
- 4. Those joining M. Com. must have passed B. Com. (R)/B.Com. (Hons.)/BBA/Bachelor of E-Commerce with at least 50% marks.

General Instructions for the Courses Under Semester System

I. Courses having Two Semester duration:

- a) There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester.
- b) In case a student fails to pass all the courses/papers within a period of two semesters (One Year), he/she shall be given two consecutive semesters (one year) more to pass.

II. Courses having Four Semester duration:

- a. There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester.
- b. However, the student shall be promoted to the third semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% course/papers of the first two semesters.
- c. There shall be no condition for promoting a student from third semester to fourth semester.
- d. In case a student fails to pass all the courses/ papers within a period of four semesters (Two Years), he/she shall be given four consecutive semesters (Two Years) more to pass.

III. Courses having Six Semester duration:

- a. There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester.
- b. However, the sudent shall be promoted to the third semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first two semesters.
- c. There shall be no condition for promoting a student from third semester to fourth semester.
- d. However, a student shall be promoted to fifth semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first four semesters.
- e. The student shall be promoted to sixth semester only if he/she has passed all the papers of the first semester. After a period of six semesters, the student shall be given a period of two consecutive years to pass.

IV. Courses having Eight Semester duration:

- a. There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester.
- b. However, the student shall be promoted to the third semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first two semesters.
- c. There shall be no condition for promoting a student from third semester to fourth semester.
- d. However, a student shall be promoted to fifth semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first four semesters.
- e. The student shall be promoted to sixth semester only if he/she has passed all the papers of the first semester.
- f. The student shall be promoted to seventh semester only if he/she has passed all the papers of first two semesters.
- g. After a period of eight semesters, the student shall be given a period of two consecutive years to pass.

The Admission Process at Hindu College

Leave Rules

- 1. Leave must be applied for and sanctioned in advance, except in emergencies when applications should be submitted on the day the student resumes studies at the College.
- 2. For leave up to four days, applicants should personally present their applications to their tutor. Once approved, the application must be submitted to the office for filing, and the student should retain the counterfoil, duly signed by the clerk-in-charge, for their records. In exceptional cases, applications may be sent by post under registered cover addressed to the Principal.
- 3. Leave cannot be granted for an indefinite period. Requests for leave lasting five days or more must be personally applied for to the Principal, accompanied by the tutor's recommendation.
- 4. Applications for extended leave due to illness must be accompanied by a certificate from the College Medical Officer. **Note:** In case of any discrepancies in the calculation of fines for absences, the counterfoil of the leave application form, signed by the clerk-in-charge, will serve as conclusive proof.

Withdrawal Procedure:

- 1. To withdraw from the College, a student must submit a written application, countersigned by their parents or guardian, before the expiry of one month after the commencement of classes. Failure to do so will render the student liable to pay all dues for the following month.
- 2. The name of a student will be removed from the College rolls under the following circumstances:
 - a) Continuous absence without leave for 15 days or more. b) Non-payment of dues by the last day of the month.
 - c) Any act of indiscipline or misconduct.

This is for the information of the students of the Hindu College Campus that "RAGGING IN ANY FORM INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE CAMPUS IS BANNED" Vide Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Orders on SLP (Civil) 24295 and 24296 of 2004- University of Kerala v/s Council, Principals of Colleges, Kerala and others, the senior students who are involved in ragging junior students may be given the following punishment:

Once the Freeship card is issued, submission of the online scholarship form along with all documents in triplicate form to the college office scholarship cell is mandatory.

Time Schedule For Payment

- Ø **July to Sept. 2024:** At the time of Admission
- Ø **Oct. to Dec. 2024:** By Oct. 30, 2024 (Including University Exam Fee)
- Ø **Jan. to March 2025:** By Jan. 30, 2025 (Including University Exam Fee)
- Ø **April to June 2025:** By Feb., 2025

Please note that once the fee is paid, it will not be refunded even if the student leaves the college midsession. Only the security deposit will be refunded.

Fines

- 1. In case of absence from the College without obtaining proper leave thereof, a fine of 1.00 per period but not exceeding 5.00 per day will be imposed on the student. A fine of 5.00 is charged for absence from a Science Practical, Composition period, Physical Training Class, Group Meeting, N.C.C. Parade, or N.S.S. Programme. The principal reserves the right to impose a special and heavier fine for any type of absence or an act of indiscipline or misbehaviour.
- 2. Absentee and examination fines are non-remittable.
- 3. The use of unfair means during examinations or any act of indiscipline/misbehaviour is punishable by a special fine.

Scooters/Motorcycles

Students bringing scooters or motorcycles to the College are required to keep them locked at the College Cycle-Stand. The fees for scooters or motorcycles are as follows:

Motor-cycle/Scooter/Moped: Rs. 1600/- per annum (Students are not allowed to bring four-wheelers to the college) At the time of surprise checking, anyone found without listing of vehicle in the College will have to pay the full year's charges.

 The scooter or motorcycle will be removed from the College list only after an application to this effect, recommended by the Professor in-charge (Cycle-Stand), is finally accepted by the Principal. Failing this, the fee shall be chargeable for the full academic session.

- 2. The College authorities are not responsible for the loss of a cycle/scooter if the same is left unlocked and is not placed in proper custody of the security guard at the cycle-stand.
- 3. The College is not responsible for the loss of accessories.

Note: For Scooter/Motorcycle, annual charges will be included with the fees.

Payment of Dues

- 1. The following schedule will be observed for the payment of fees:
- i) **1st Installment:** At the time of admission
- ii) **2nd Installment** (Along with University Exam. Fee): October, 2024
- iii) 3rd Installment: January, 2025
- iv) 4th Instalment (Along with University Exam. Fee): February, 2025
- 2. All fees and other dues must be paid on the dates specified, after which a fine of Rs. 20/- per day will be charged.
- 3. The names of the students whose dues are in arrear at the end of a month are liable to be struck off the rolls at the beginning of the next month. Such students will be re-admitted on payment of their dues along with the re-admission fee.
- 4. Absence from college, with or without leave, will not be accepted as an excuse for non-payment of fees on the due date. Dues will be accepted from absentees when sent by M.O. or by Indian Postal Orders or by Bank Draft.
- 5. Fees and fines once paid will not be refunded.
- 6. Students whose dues are in arrear will not be issued character or other certificates until the dues are cleared. This applies to old students as well.


