THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "MOU") is entered at Hindu College, Amritsar on 80 1 20.

Between

Hindu College, Amritsar, Punjab, established in 1924, has a long tradition of pursuing excellence in teaching and research in science and technology, humanities, social sciences, performing arts and sports. The college supports excellence and innovation in academic programmes, promotes excellence in research, scholarship and teaching.

And

Majha House SS Gill Trust which offers a unique space and facility that conceptualizes, plans and executes a number of initiatives to showcase the best in literature, performance, art and culture, attracting the best and brightest. This includes initiatives to locate and showcase the intellectual and cultural heritage of Punjab; encourage cutting edge research in the arts; and workshops and trainings especially for young people to come to learn and grow their skills and build interface and linkages nationally and internationally and on on-going basis.

Hindu College, Amritsar and Majha House individually referred to herein as a 'party' and collectively as the 'parties'.

A: Preamble:

Today, Hindu College, Amritsar feels proud of the 16 academic departments housed in its campus. Track record of employment of our students by big business Houses and Multi-National

Our students of management and computers are successfully employed by companies in India and abroad. They are all contributing to the credit worthiness of the college by their hard work and diligence.

Whereas, Majha House (or Billoo's house as it has been called after the gallantry of Lt SS Gill who died fighting for the country in 1971) is a 40 year old home with a history of giving, martyrdom and gallantry. It has been witness to loss but also renewal and regeneration that represents the indomitable spirit of Punjab. In March 2018 we opened the house as a community space that celebrates Punjab's culture and literature as well as seeks to bring the best writers and performers from across the country to Amritsar. A family home has thus become an open community space – to encourage the free flow of arts and ideas, debate and discussion, and critical thinking

Both Parties feel that collaboration between **Hindu College** and **Majha House** will enhance the strength and add value to the efforts of each party;

The Parties therefore agree on the objective of creating an institutional framework for enriching scientific endeavors in mutually agreed fields of academics, research, training and placements with the following broad objectives and scope:

B: Broad Objectives and Scope:

Objectives

- To locate and showcase the intellectual and cultural heritage of the Majha and Punjab and build interface and linkages.
- To establish strong cooperation between the parties for long-term partnership & to develop synergetic collaborations in resource sharing and knowledge sharing activities in matters of common interest
- To develop academic program and share expertise in training and other academic events through joint organization of events.

5. To develop collaborations with different agencies in the world of art and culture, including film and television industry.

Scope

The scope of Majha House and Hindu College, Amritsar collaboration can include (but not restricted to) activities below:

- Conducting guest lectures, seminars, and workshops on collaborative basis by inviting
 the best writers, journalists, academics, performers and artists from across the country to
 deliver talks at the college for the students and faculty.
- Organize Workshops and Professional trainings in collaboration with the Department of English and Computer Science on a host of subjects like Publishing, Creative Writing, Translation, Film Making and Editing, Photography, Film Appreciation, Art Appreciation, Script Writing, Theatre etc.
- Conducing student interactions with Industry leaders for better understanding of the business world and requirements.
- 4. On the Job Training / Internship Programs and Campus recruitment.
- Majha House Trustees and Advisors include leaders of TV industry and they can contribute to curate course material and guest lectures.

C: Mode of Operation:

Both parties will provide necessary support for effective implementation of the MOU within the institutional rules and procedures

- 1. This MOU shall be effective from the date it is signed by both the Parties.
- Within the broad framework of the MOU, Majha House and GNDU can develop joint research, academic exchanges, development of facilities, etc.
- Any financial commitment for joint activities under this MOU shall be subject to the approval by the competent authority of the respective organizations.
- 4. The activities under this MOU shall be coordinated, monitored and recorded by an Internal Coordination Committee constituted of members nominated by both parties; each organization will appoint an internal coordinator who will organize joint meetings at regular intervals at mutually agreed locations and maintain records of agreements, work plan and progress.

- 5. The Internal Coordination Committee will formulate action plans at its meetings and communicate for information and necessary approvals by the concerned authorities
 - 6. The mode and quantum of resource sharing will be decided based on recommendation of the Internal Coordination Committee on the case to case basis, subject to approval of competent authority as required.

D: Obligations of the Parties

- In accordance with the clause C-4 as above, Dr Gurpartap Singh, Department of English, will be the Internal Coordinator from Hindu College, Amritsar, whereas, Ms. Preeti Gill, Founder, Majha House or a person nominated by her, will be the Internal Coordinator from Majha House.
- Each party shall nominate four members to the Internal Coordination Committee within 15 days of signing the MOU.
- Each Party shall provide all necessary support at its disposal and as allowed by its institutional Rules, for implementing this MOU effectively.
- 4. The Parties shall share knowledge and facilities within the institutional Rules of each Party, to:
 - (a) Provide access to libraries, research laboratories and other facilities;
 - (b) Provide access to conference rooms, auditoriums, and other facilities as mutually agreed;
 - (c) Share knowledge/ information as necessary and feasible. and
 - (d) No financial commitment from either Organization shall be assumed unless a formal approval/acceptance to that effect has been accorded through signed documents by both the Organizations.

E: Duration and Termination

1. This MOU shall remain in force for a period of Four years from the date of signing of this agreement. However, where after, it may be automatically renewed for an extended period for Four years subsequently overtime unless any of the parties seek termination in writing.

This MOU may be terminated with at least three months' notice given in writing and with the written consent of the Heads of the two organizations.

3. Upon termination of this MOU between the participating components, the parties (Hindu College and Majha House) will be indemnified from any third-party agreements/ obligation including but not limited to claims, liabilities, losses, damages, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses.

F: Data Sharing and Intellectual Property Rights

1. No rights in Industrial and/or Intellectual Property (Including without limitation, letters, patent, registered design, software copyrights, trademark and copyright) owned by the Parties on the date of signature of this MOU and independently developed on their part are hereby granted by the owning Party to the other Party, nor shall any such rights be deemed to be granted except specified by the owning Party in writing.

The Intellectual Property Rights in respect of joint project will be decided on case-to-case basis.

 Sharing of any data generated (either observational or computational) under the aegis of this MOU shall be as per the provisions of the specific projects/programmes.

4. Each Party shall duly acknowledge the contribution/involvement of the other Party in a

given activity in its bulletins/publications/media release/outreach and any other official communication.

5. Every member of both Parties in any activity under the aegis of this MOU shall abide by the prevailing policies of Govt. of India with respect to classified information/data. During the tenure of this MOU including extension, if any and for *Five years* thereafter, Parties undertake on their behalf and on behalf of their employees or representatives or associates to maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure thereof to any third party, all the information and data exchanged or generated during the operation of MOU.

G: GENERAL PROVISIONS

BIV WHITE

 Neither Party shall assign, or in any manner, transfer its interest or any part thereof in this MOU, except to wholly owned subsidiaries and agreed explicitly to that effect in writing.

- 2. This MOU constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties relating to the subject matter hereof and supersedes and cancels any and all previous or collateral MOUs, negotiations, commitments, representations or understandings between the Parties with respect to this MOU, and the subject matter hereof. If any of the provisions of this MOU are determined to be invalid under applicable law, they are, to that extent, deemed omitted. The invalidity of any portion of this MOU shall not render any other portion invalid; and,
 - 3. No amendments or modifications of this MOU shall be valid unless they are made in writing by both the Parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MOU. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made or executed unless otherwise agreed to; and,
 - 4. This MOU is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise recognize a joint venture, partnership, or formal business organization of any kind, and the rights and

obligations of the Parties shall be only those expressly set forth herein. Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to grant either Party the right to make commitments of any kind for or on behalf of the other without the other's prior written consent.

H: FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Parties shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this MOU due to the exigency of one or more of the Force Majeure events such as, but not limited to, the acts of God, War, Flood, Earthquake, Strikes, Lockouts, Epidemic, Riots, Civil commotions etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the Party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other Party within 30 (Thirty) days of such occurrence or cessation. If the Force Majeure conditions continue beyond 6 (six) months, the Parties shall jointly decide about the future course of action.

I: GOVERNING LAWS AND DISPUTES RESOLUTION

- This MOU shall, in all respects, be governed by and construed in all respects in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India.
- This MOU is to create a framework for enriching scientific endeavors in mutually agreed fields of research through collaboration in developing and implementing new academic

and research programmes and faculty and students exchange. Hence any question, doubt or dispute arising out of the interpretation of any term or usage herein or on the implementation and functioning of the various understandings forming a part of this MOU shall be resolved by the Executive Heads of the two organizations or their authorized representatives for the purpose mentioned herein by discussions and negotiations based on consensus in the spirit of developing and strengthening the mutual relationships.

- 3. Any unresolved dispute, shall be referred to The Principal, Hindu college, Amritsar, and Managing Trustee of Majha House and an independent arbitrator involved with mutual consent in accordance with Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and rules framed thereof. CO-OPERATION


